

SAMPLE SUBMISSION PROCEDURES for Midge Tolerant Wheat Refuge Testing

Please submit one sample for each field or CSGA Crop Sequence Number.

Supplies required for each sample:

- SRC's GenServe Laboratories™ Sample Submission Form (2 pages)
 - 2 large paper envelopes – resealable and unmarked
 - 250 grams (approximately ½ lb) of untreated wheat seeds
 - Cardboard prepaid mailer (obtain from Canada Post or courier company)
1. Complete all sections of the Sample Submission Form as provided by SRC's GenServe Laboratories™. Forms are available from the Canadian Seed Growers' Association, Seed Distributors or online at www.genserve.ca
 2. Label a large paper envelope with the Grower's name and seed sample identification (ie, RSE, Sequence or Field number).
 3. Deposit 250 grams (approximately ½ lb) of the seed to be tested in the labeled paper envelope. **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS.** The seeds being submitted for testing should not have been treated.
 4. Enclose page one (1) of the completed Sample Submission form inside the envelope containing the seed sample. Seal the envelope.
 5. Address the second large paper envelope to the following:

 6. Insert the envelope containing the seeds and form inside the second envelope that has been addressed to the lab. It is important to have two separate envelopes to ensure that seeds are not lost or mixed during transit.
 7. Enclose the sealed envelope in the cardboard mailer that is also addressed to SRC's GenServe Laboratories™.

Samples will be accepted by SRC's GenServe Laboratories™ effective October 1, 2009

**Test results for samples received prior to December 15, 2009
are targeted to be reported by March 31, 2010.**

1. SRC performs the Services in a professional manner in accordance with applicable industry standards. SRC makes no other representations or warranties, either express or implied, statutory or otherwise, as to any matter, including, but not limited to, the quality, merchantability or fitness for any purpose of any Services, goods, or products to be delivered pursuant to these Terms of Service, and all such representations and warranties are hereby disclaimed.
 2. Test results are dependent on the samples that have been submitted and your compliance with any submission procedures communicated to you by SRC.
 3. SRC’s liability in respect of the Services shall be limited to, at SRC’s option, repayment of the amount paid for the Services that are proven to be defective or re-performance of the Services claimed to be defective. In no event shall SRC be liable to you or any other person for (i) indirect damages, special damages, lost profits, consequential damages, or punitive damages; or (ii) any amount in excess of the amount paid or payable by you (or a third party on your behalf) to SRC for the Services that are the subject of this submission.
 4. This agreement shall be governed by, construed, and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of Saskatchewan and the laws of Canada applicable therein. The parties shall attorn to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the Province of Saskatchewan and all courts competent to hear appeals therefrom.
 5. SRC will endeavour to store the submitted sample at its premises for a period of thirty (30) days from the date the test results are reported. The sample and any corresponding extracted DNA will be disposed of after the thirty (30) day storage period.
 6. SRC will report the test results to the Grower using the contact information on page one (1) of the submission form that accompanied the sample. As well, test results will be reported to the Canadian Seed Growers’ Association and the respective Seed Distributor as follows:
