Pre-Mine Scanning

Scanning

- Radiation scanning for equipment, trailers and vehicles ahead of access to sites with radiological conditions
- Flexible and rapid service to keep timelines on-schedule
- Available to travel to construction yards, rental or parking lots, or can provide scanning services from SRC's location

Post-Mine Scanning

- Radiation scanning for contaminated equipment, vehicles and trailers after elevated radioactive product delivery
- Works with clients to clean and scan equipment simultaneously, until radiation levels are acceptable

Additional Radiological Services

- ▶ Plan and carry out radiological surveys
- ▶ Process and visualize gamma radiation exposure data
- Analyze results and provide monitoring recommendations
- Develop numeric-based risk modelling and risk assessment
- Conduct independent reviews of survey results and risk assessments
- ▶ Calibrate survey equipment on concrete pads
