



## Lorado Mill Photo Contest Rules

Official Contest Rules for the Lorado Mill Photo Contest (the “Contest”) offered by the Saskatchewan Research Council (“SRC”). The Contest gives you a chance to win the prize(s) described in these Contest rules (the “Rules”). The Contest will run from May 20, 2019 until September 30, 2019 (the "Contest Period").

BY ENTERING THE CONTEST, AN ENTRANT REPRESENTS THAT HE OR SHE SATISFIES ALL OF THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THESE RULES AND AGREES TO BE BOUND UNCONDITIONALLY BY THESE RULES AND ALL DECISIONS OF SRC, WHICH ARE FINAL AND BINDING WITH RESPECT TO ALL MATTERS RELATING TO THE CONTEST.

- 1. Participation:** Entry into this Contest is free and does not require any purchase. During the Contest Period, entrants can submit up to 20 original photographs (the “Photo”) by (i) emailing the Photo to [cleans@src.sk.ca](mailto:cleans@src.sk.ca), along with the contest entry form available at [src.nu/loradocontestform](http://src.nu/loradocontestform). If you cannot email the photos, you can contact a member of the Project CLEANS team at [cleans@src.sk.ca](mailto:cleans@src.sk.ca) to arrange another way to submit your photos with your entry form. Entrants can also contact [cleans@src.sk.ca](mailto:cleans@src.sk.ca) to be sent the contest entry form. All contest participants must fill out an entry form and include it with their photos.
- 2. Photo Requirement:** To be eligible for the Contest, the Photo must meet the following requirements: (i) if the Photo is a close-up, a second photo is required that shows the location context (i.e. to verify the close-up was taken at site), (ii) the Photo must include one of the following: wildlife, vegetation, or landscape, (iii) the Photo must be taken at the tailings area at the Former Lorado Mill Site, (iv) the Photo must not include persons, (v) the Photo must be an original and belong to the entrant, (vi) entrants must have completed the contest entry form, (vii) the Photo must have been taken between 2017 and 2019, and (viii) the Photo needs to be submitted as an electronic photo file (e.g., JPG, PNG) and be taken at the highest resolution possible and submitted at the largest file size possible. Hard copies of photos must be scanned so they can be used digitally.
- 3. Limit:** The Contest is limited to one entry per person and each entrant can submit up to 20 photos into multiple categories. Entrants are eligible to win a prize in more than one category. This Contest ends on the closing date identified above. Entries received after the closing date will be disqualified.
- 4. Prizes:** There are six prizes available to be won. Two prizes will be available for each of the following categories: (i) Wildlife, (ii) Vegetation and (iii) Landscape. The Contest prize for each category consists of (i) a \$100 Visa gift card and SRC swag, with an approximate value of \$50. The chances of winning depend upon the number of eligible entries received. If no entries are received for a category, SRC will award extra winners in other categories if applicable. No prize may be redeemed for cash or transferred. All prizes are awarded "AS IS" and WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, express or implied (including, without limitation, any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose). No prize substitutions are allowed, except at SRC’s sole discretion. If for any reason a prize cannot be awarded as described in these Rules, a prize of equal or greater value may be substituted by SRC in its sole discretion. All incidental costs and expenses not specifically referred to herein are not included and are the sole responsibility of the winner.
- 5. Prize Winners:** There will be two prize-awarding periods. The first group of winners will be selected on or before July 31, 2019. The second group of winners will be selected on or before September 30, 2019. A panel of judges from SRC’s Project CLEANS team will choose the winning photos for each of the three categories, based on the following criteria: appropriateness to category, composition, originality, creativity and quality, and represents the Lorado Mill Site.
- 6. Eligibility:** The Contest is open only to residents of the Athabasca Basin. Entrants must have reached the age of majority in the province or territory in which they reside to enter.
- 7. Consent to Use Info:** By participating in the Contest, each entrant consents to the collection, use and

disclosure of his or her personal information and other information submitted pursuant to these Rules by SRC for the purposes of administering the Contest (which includes awarding prizes and announcing the winner) and to contact the entrant for the purposes of marketing SRC's services to the entrant. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, SRC may contact the entrant at an electronic address using an electronic message. An entrant may withdraw consent to SRC by contacting SRC using an electronic message and/or may withdraw its consent to SRC's use of its information for the marketing purposes described above by contacting SRC at John Sprague, 125-15 Innovation Boulevard, Saskatoon, Sask. By entering the Contest, all entrants hereby grant to SRC the unlimited right (but not the obligation) to publish and use, without payment or other compensation and without notice, consent or approval, his/her name, photograph and likeness, address (city/town and province/territory), voice, and the whole or part of any statement or statements he/she has made or makes about the Contest or a prize in any publicity, program or advertising, without geographic limit and in perpetuity, in any medium now known or hereafter devised (including, without limitation, the Internet), and hereby consents unconditionally to any such publication or use without further notice, consent, approval or compensation.

8. **Consent to Use Photo:** By entering the Contest, each entrant: (i) grants to SRC, in perpetuity, a world-wide, non-exclusive license to publish, display, reproduce, modify, edit or otherwise use his or her winning Photo, in whole or in part, for advertising or promoting the Contest or for any other reason; (ii) waives all moral rights in and to his or her winning Photo in favour of SRC; and (iii) agrees to release and hold harmless SRC and SRC's directors, officers and employees against any and all claims based on publicity rights, defamation, invasion of privacy, copyright infringement, trade-mark infringement or any other intellectual property related cause of action. SRC will, where possible, credit entrants for their winning Photo.
9. **Selection:** If the selected winner is not reached within thirty (30) business days following the draw of the winner or if SRC determines (in its sole discretion) that the selected winner does not meet all of the Contest

conditions described in these Rules, then another participant will be chosen from among the eligible winners and will be declared the winner. This process will be repeated until a selected eligible winner is declared a winner of a prize.

#### **10. General Rules**

11. All entries are subject to verification and may be declared invalid if they are determined by SRC, in its sole discretion, to violate these Rules.
12. By participating in the Contest, each entrant represents and warrants that he or she has the power and authority to submit the Photo entered and to grant the rights herein and that all Photos submitted will not infringe any copyright, trademark, trade secret or invade or violate any right of any person, including in relation to any privacy or personality right, infringe any other proprietary right or contain anything libelous or obscene.
13. SRC is not responsible for late, lost, damaged, misdirected, mutilated, garbled, illegible or incomplete entries. Proof of transmission and/or mailing of an entry does not constitute proof of delivery or receipt by SRC. Any entries obtained through unauthorized or illegitimate sources/channels, or which are not original, are illegible, have been tampered with, mutilated, altered, reproduced, stolen, forged, counterfeited, irregular, marked improperly, or which contain printing or production errors, or any errors in any way, will be void at the discretion of SRC.
14. By entering the Contest, each entrant hereby releases SRC and SRC's directors, officers and employees from any and all liability whatsoever, and waives any and all causes of action, related to any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to any person or persons (including, without limitation, death or personal injuries, property damage, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation or portrayal in a false light, whether intentional or unintentional) resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from acceptance, possession, use and misuse of, and inability to use, any prize or any part of any prize or otherwise related in any way whatsoever to participation in the Contest.
15. By entering the Contest, each entrant agrees to fully indemnify and hold harmless SRC and SRC's directors, officers and employees against any and all liability, damages or causes of action (however named or

described) with respect to or arising out of: (i) such entrant's participation in the Contest, (ii) the receipt or use of any prizes awarded therein; and (iii) the administration of the Contest and distribution of the prizes awarded therein.

16. SRC is not responsible for commencing, continuing or completing the Contest draws or awarding the prizes in the event of circumstances beyond the control of SRC. If for any reason the Contest cannot be executed as planned, SRC reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to modify or suspend the Contest in whole or in part.

17. The Contest is governed by the laws of the Province of Saskatchewan. If any provision of this Rules is legally unenforceable, the remaining terms of this Rules will remain enforceable.
