

## 2017 Main Accomplishments

- Field work at 27 of the 35 sites
- Permanent closure of 7 openings
- Historical debris and hazardous waste removal at 11 sites
- Desktop assessments of 8 sites
- Visit of 5 remote sites
- Wildlife and archeological surveys
- Environmental monitoring and radiation surveys
- Survey for design of permanent closure of openings
- Repair to Goldfields Road
- Application for transfer of 6 sites to Institutional Control Program (ICP)















## Hazardous Underground Areas

- Assessments of 28 underground areas at 3 mines near Uranium City
  - > 15 assessed as hazardous and require remediation








## Options to Address Hazards

- > Options discussed with Ministry of Environment, Ministry of Economy and Ministry of Labour Relations and Workplace Safety (Mines Branch):
  - Close access roads
  - Berms (soil mounds)
  - > Fence
- Preferred option: Fence
  - Advantages:
    - Prevent access to hazardous areas
    - Reduce hazards adequately
    - Reasonable cost
    - Balance cost and reduction of risks
    - Relatively easy to install
  - Disadvantages:
    - Susceptible to damage by vegetation, vandalism, etc.
    - Regular maintenance



#### Fenced Areas Cinch/Cenex


- Total perimeter: 700 m (2,400 ft),
- Total area: 17 ha (42 acres)




#### Fenced Areas Rix-Smitty

Chain-link with barbed wire (2 m)














#### **Access Trails Closures**

- Permanent closure of access trails: St-Michael, Cayzor, Rix-Leonard/Smitty, Cinch-Cenex, Pitch Ore – Beaverlodge, NL Pat Claims
- Temporary closure of Goldfields Road in the spring to prevent damage



## 2018 Preliminary Plan

- Continued site assessment, environmental monitoring and radiation surveys
- Design, fabricate and transport of 8-12 caps to be installed in 2019
- Planning and field preparation for installation of fences around hazardous underground areas in 2019
- Variety of minor remediation work
- Reporting of 2 completed sites
