

Detection of CDC Triffid Flax (Event FP967) Information Sheet

Biotechnology Laboratories offers a diagnostic test for the detection of GMO in flaxseed samples. The method used is based on the method “NOST-Spec Construct-specific Method for the Detection of CDC Triffid Flax (Event FP967) using Real-time PCR.”

- **TEST** – One test is available:
 - Four (4) replicate test: this test is performed on 4 X 60g of seeds
- **FEES** – Fees per sample:
 - Fee per sample is : **\$204.75** (incl. tax)
 - Please submit payment of the fees with the sample to be tested. Payment is accepted by Visa, MasterCard or cheque payable to Saskatchewan Research Council.
- **SAMPLE SIZE:**
 - 2 kg of flaxseed (4.4 lbs)
 - Roasted seed is not acceptable for testing.
- **RESULTS:**
 - Test results are presented in a certificate produced by Crop Genomics Laboratory. The turn-around-time for test results is approximately 5 business days from the day the sample is received in the lab.

2. Test results are dependent on the samples that have been submitted and your compliance with any submission procedures communicated to you by SRC.
3. SRC’s liability in respect of the Services shall be limited to, at SRC’s option, repayment of the amount paid by you for the Services that are proven to be defective or re-performance of the Services claimed by you to be defective.
